


Montel understands the meaning of the words conservation and preservation when suggesting its renowned 4-Post or cantilever shelving systems for the safe storage of books. These shelving systems offer strength, rigidity, and safety features to protect books from being damaged. Furthermore, they meet and even exceed the Uniform Building Code (UBC) and the Library Technology Report (LTR) for seismic zones and quality requirements.



The closed uprights protect books from being damaged and conceal electrical wiring safely and discreetly.



The **four-bend** edges eliminate roughness while protecting the books and reinforcing the shelves.



The minimal space usually allocated and the controlled environment conditions necessary for the preservation of paintings and framed art works define the need for specialized storage solutions. Montel offers solutions for different environments and for collections of any size.

Montel's fixed or sliding art rack systems permit not only the individual storage of paintings, but **ensure complete protection and free access to them.** Double sided metallic mesh maximizes hanging surfaces and provides necessary ventilation. All sliding art racks are equipped with ballbearing wheels and anti-tip device for the **safe and steady movement** of each individual rack. Art works cannot be damaged since mesh panels are separated from one another. Objects are suspended with specially designed safety hooks.

The configuration of the sliding pull-out art panels can vary depending on the dimension of the paintings and the type of storage required.



By eliminating non-productive aisles, Mobilex high density storage systems create new space availability inside existing facilities. This additional space can be used for new purposes or to double the storage capacity of any given area while preserving total accessibility. Mobilex systems can accommodate 4-post shelving, cantilever shelving, cabinets, wide span shelving, or any other type of shelving or cabinet.

All the electric systems are equipped with the following safety features:

• DC motor with soft start/soft stop carriage movement as well as proximity sensors minimize the stopping impact, reduce vibrations that may cause stress on your collections.
